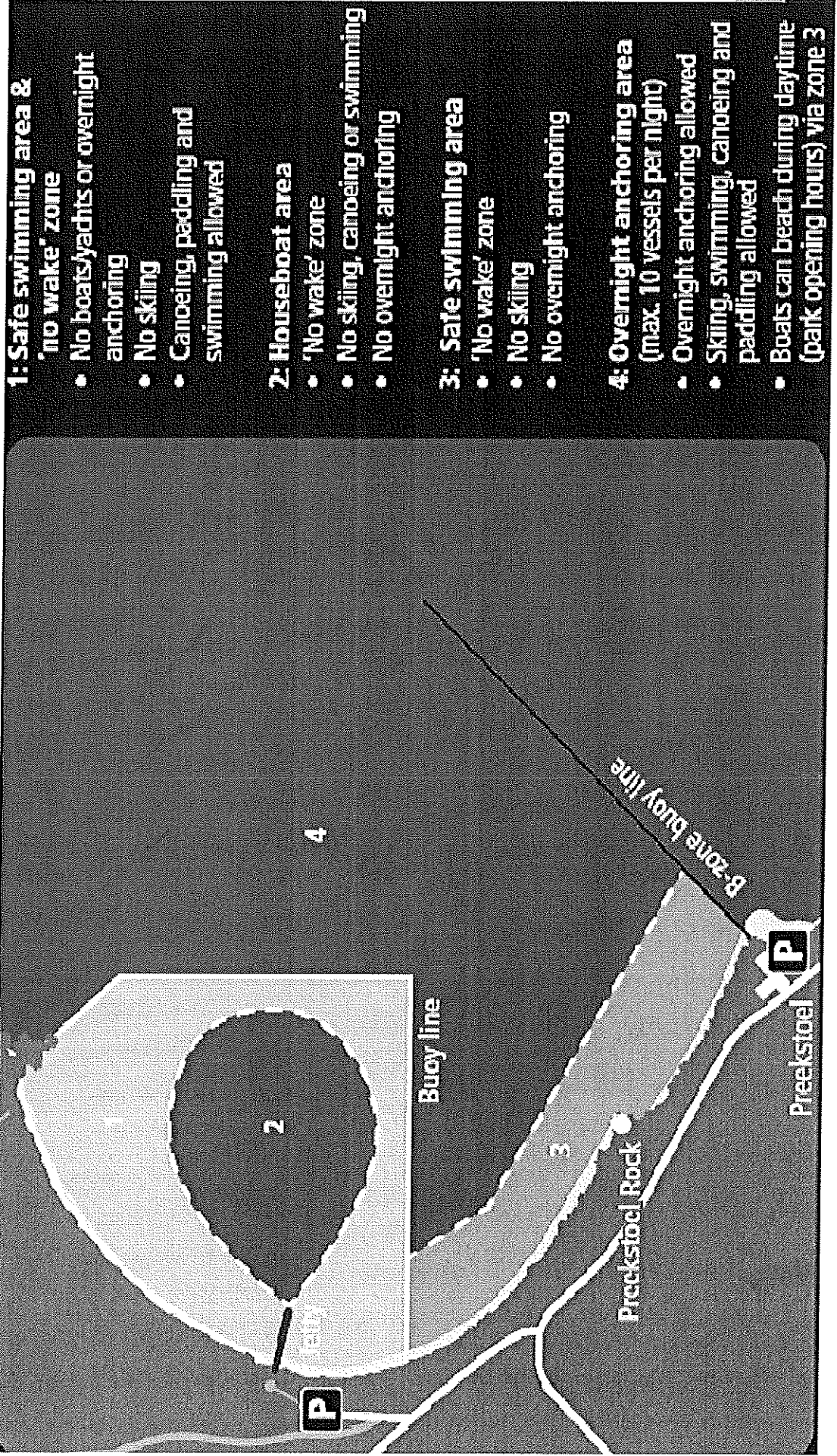


Kraalbaai: new sign

1: Safe swimming area & 'no wake' zone

- No boats/yachts or overnight anchoring
- No skiing
- Canoeing, paddling and swimming allowed

2: Houseboat area

- 'No wake' zone
- No skiing, canoeing or swimming
- No overnight anchoring

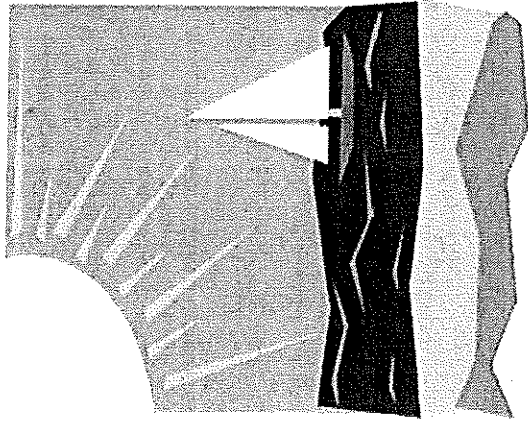
3: Safe swimming area

- 'No wake' zone
- No skiing
- No overnight anchoring

4: Overnight anchoring area (max. 10 vessels per night)

- Overnight anchoring allowed
- Skiing, swimming, canoeing and paddling allowed
- Boats can beach during daytime (park opening hours) via zone 3

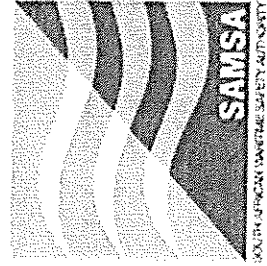

Overnight Anchorage Guidelines

- Maximum of 10 vessels per night
- Reservations must be done with WCNP office - roomseeker reservations system
- Daily Conservation fees are applicable
- Anchorage is only permitted in area 4 in Kraalbaai
- Overnight anchoring of vessels are only allowed for recreational users.
- No commercial operators\yachts\vessels are allowed to overnight.
- No fishing allowed after 9pm at Kraalbaai
- Vessels must be in possession of SANParks boat permit
- No anchoring allowed in marine zone B
